In this program, students work with the latest Porsche-provided equipment and vehicles. Graduates gain the ability to achieve Bronze level certification within their first year on the job at a Porsche dealership. As part of the training, students put in 200 miles behind the wheel of Porsche vehicles in order to familiarize themselves with the models they'll work on in the field.

Porsche provides rent-free student housing and only a nominal maintenance fee will be paid while attending PTAP.
